ARMY FOUNDATION COLLEGE HARROGATE (AFC) - COURSE LENGTH

There are two courses, a long and short course. Which one students join will depend on the job they are hoping to do in the Army. If they are on the short course they will have three weeks off, mid-term, while those doing the long course will have eight weeks off.

SHORT COURSE (20 WEEKS)

Army Air Corps, Adjutant General's Corps (SPS), Royal Signals, Army Medical Corps, Royal Engineers, Royal Logistic Corps, Royal Electrical & Mechanical Engineers, Corps of Army Music

LONG COURSE (40 WEEKS)

Infantry, Royal Armoured Corps, Royal Artillery, Household Cavalry, Royal Logistic Corps.

Enhanced Bursary Up to £24,000

Students can apply either before or during their first year, they will get £6,000 in years 1 - 3 and a further £6,000 when they commission. If students apply in their second year of university, they will receive £9,000 in years 2 & 3 and £6,000 when they commission. Students with at least ABB at A Level and on track for at least a 2:1 degree can apply.

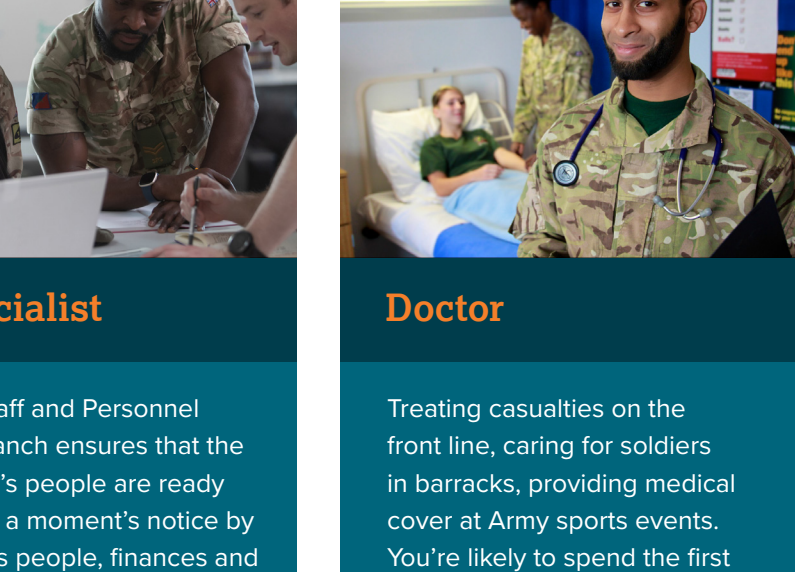

LEVEL 4 - APPRENTICESHIP DATA ANALYST

Students can get a level 4 Data Analyst apprenticeship when they join the Intelligence Corps within the Army. As an Intelligence Operative you'll gather and analyse information that helps senior commanders make important decisions. You'll work in variety of roles and settings, from headquarters units to government departments, becoming a subject-matter expert in a country or an enemy threat.
